Comments: Characteristics: The integrated construct consist of a ubiquitous CAGGS (hybrid chicken beta actin and cytomegalovirus) promoter, a loxP-STOP-loxP (LSL) cassette and the Myc-FLAG-tagged NR/CoR cDNA followed by a polyadenylation signal. The construct is silent and the integrated gene can be conditionally overexpressed after cre recombinase mediated activation (PubMed=20382891).
