Comments: Discontinued; manufacturer recommendations: ELISA; Preliminary experiments gave an approx. 30kDa band in Human Liver, Lung and Tonsil lysates after 1µg/ml antibody staining. Please note that currently we cannot find an explanation in the literature for the band we observe given the calculated size of 60.3kDa according to NP_001259.1. The 30kDa band was successfully blocked by incubation with the immunizing peptide. We would appreciate any feedback from people in the field - have any results been reported with other antibodies/lysates? Have any further splice variants/modified forms been reported? This antibody is not expected to cross-react with RCBTB1. ELISA.
