Comments: Discontinued; manufacturer recommendations: ELISA; Preliminary experiments gave an approx 150kDa band in Human Cerebellum lysates after 0.1µg/ml antibody staining. Please note that currently we cannot find an explanation in the literature for the band we observe given the calculated size of 57.7kDa according to NP_065105.2. The 150kDa band was successfully blocked by incubation with the immunizing peptide. We would appreciate any feedback from people in the field - have any results been reported with other antibodies/lysates? Have any further splice variants/modified forms been reported? This antibody is expected to recognize both reported isoforms NP_065105.2 and NP_057693.3). ELISA.
