Comments: Discontinued; manufacturer recommendations: ELISA, Immunohistochemistry. Preliminary experiments gave an approx 35kDa band in Testis and Brain lysates after 0.3µg/ml antibody staining. Please note that currently we cannot find an explanation in the literature for the band we observe given the calculated size of 221kDa according to NP_038478. The 35kDa band was successfully blocked by incubation with the immunizing peptide. We would appreciate any feedback from people in the field - have any results been reported with other antibodies/lysates? Have any further splice variants/modified forms been reported? In paraffin embedded Human Small Intestine shows primarily nuclear staining in a number of cells of the lamina propria. Recommended concentration, 1-2µg/ml.; ELISA; Immunohistochemistry
