It is unknown if it will work on endogenous samples. This antibody has also been tested in immunocytochemistry (human paraffin-embedded sections only) and immunoprecipitation. No other applications have been tested. Suggested working dilutions: * Western Blot - 1:2000 Immunocytochemistry - 1:500 (human) Immunoprecipitation - 5 ul/ml (1:200) *The investigator should determine the optimal working dilution for a specific application.; Western Blot
