Comments: Methylase that recognizes the double-stranded sequence CTGCAG, causes specific methylation on A-5 on both strands, and protects the DNA from cleavage by the PstI endonuclease. The plasmids in the Open Enzyme collection contain genetic parts and are not functional by themselves. Researchers can clone these enzymes into an expression vector of their choice and then transform into E. coli bacteria for expression and purification.
