This fragment was cloned into the NotI/SalI sites of pCMVscript. To complete its open reading frame, a BglII fragment of this plasmid was replaced by a cDNA amplified from mouse brain using the following primers: GGCCAGATCTCCGCACGGCCGCCACAGGACCACC and CGCGAGATCTGTTGCCGTTGTGCTTGAGGGAGAC.
