Comments: Derived from Ted, a centromeric plasmid (provided by W. Kramer) marked by the URA3 gene. Contains two copies of the Escherichia coli lacZ gene in inverted orientation, with one copy containing an HO endonuclease cleavage site. Please note: Addgene was not able to sequence verify the critical features of this plasmid due to its repetitive nature.

Plasmid Name: pFP121

Relevant Mutation: The second lacZ sequence has been modified, the EcoRV/BclI fragment has been replaced by a 20-bp sequence (AGTTTCAGCTTTTATAAAC), so that the nonhomologous sequences in the cut lacZ repeat are only 10 bp long on each side of the DSB. Second LacZ HO site is no longer present.
