Comments: The sequence inserted into the pCR2.1 vector is larger than just the magA gene. The magA gene is preceded by 373 bp of genomic DNA and followed by 30 bp of genomic DNA. The gene contains 2 amino acid substitutions - S94L and P390S. The cloned gene was used primarily as a probe. Also see Zurkiya et al. Magn Reson Med. 2008 Jun;59(6):1225-31.
