Comments: Lentiviral vector with high transduction efficiency. Expression from the CMV-EF1? hybrid (CEF) promoter is very stable in mammalian cells. The lentivirus contains an SV40 origin 5' to the eGFP gene. This influences gene targeting rates and the preferred strand for gene targeting and recombineering in cells expressing the SV40 T-antigen.

Plasmid Name: pDual-eGFP(W66)

Relevant Mutation: Changed tyrosine at position 66 with respect to the original eGFP sequence to tryptophan. The DNA sequence change corresponds to AC at nucleotide 317-318 to GG.
