Analysis is supported for Illumina data, all CNV-reports and raw data can be imported after third-party analysis. Platform to streamline processing and downstream interpretation of microarray data in clinical context. Analysis tools include CNV analysis, parent of origin and uniparental disomy detection. Interpretation tools include data visualisation, gene prioritisation, automated PubMed searching, linking data to several genome browsers and annotation of CNVs based on several public databases.
