It allows researchers to perform 2-D image segmentation in brain MR image data. Each interactive visualization element corresponding to the embedded function enables the end user to easily manipulate the image data. The visual environment of this tool provides an easy-to-use means of inspection and interpretation of image data using the LONI jViewbox library. CFMBIS uses the Java Image I/O plug-in architecture to read a wide variety of common medical image file formats.
